CEPP Education Grants Update:

The Ontario Ministry of Energy has approved an expansion of the Community Energy Partnerships Program to include Education Grants, making a total of \$500,000 available to eligible Ontario co-ops, not-for-profits and charities. CEPP Education Grants will provide up to \$125,000 per project to engage Ontario communities to develop renewable energy projects. Full details of the Education Grant Program will be released soon so please stay tuned ...

CEPP Grants Support 49 Projects, \$550 Million in Projects in Ontario:

Since the launch of the CEPP in May 2010, 46 renewable energy projects across the province have received \$3.1 million in CEPP funding to assist in early stage development costs. Solar, wind, water and biogas projects totaling over 50 MW of green power support total project costs of over \$191 million being spent in community power development in Ontario.
